The Beatles Please Please Me covers were shot here.

Famous for the legendary 'Beatles', & the pedestrian crossing.

**3. Beatles final gig, 3 Savile Row, London**

The scene of the last ever Beatles gig, on the rooftops here.

**4. Beatles first no.1 written here, 57 Wimpole Street, London**

This is where the Beatles wrote Yesterday and Eleanor Rigby.

**5. Beatles Manager Last Day, 24 Chapel Street**

Epstein died at this address in 1967 after excess drug use

**6. City Barge, 27 Strand On The Green**

The pub was in The Beatles 'Help' and 'A Hard Day's Night' films

**7. Cook, Lennon and Dinner Parties, 17 Church Row**

Beatles epic was written and fuelled by happy evenings here

**8. Decca: Birth of Rock n roll, 165 Broadhurst Gardens**

Former home of Decca Records and the birth of British rock music

**9. Dorchester Hotel & Prince Philip, *The Dorchester Hotel, Park Lane, London***

Peter Sellers heart attack and Prince Phillips stag occured here

**10. Fab Four Tailoring, *161 King's Road***

'Apple Tailoring, Civil and Theatrical' once traded here.

**11. George Harrison's Hare Temple, *Bhaktivedanta Manor, Dharam Marg, Hilfield lane,***

The manor that George Harrison lived in and became a Hare temple

**12. HMV's first Celebrity Opening, *363 Oxford Street***

HMV's first store in London, and first celebrity opening.

**13. Home to Beatlemania, *13 Monmouth Street***

A little piece of Beatle history was founded here

**14. Home to the Nemperor, *3 Hill Street, Mayfair***

Daft name for quite a successful music management man

**15. John & Cynthia's Original Pad, *13 Emperor's Gate, Knightsbridge***

The Lennon's once lived here before fans took over their lives

**16. John and Yoko's Nude Scene, *38 Montagu Square, London***

John Lennon and Yoko Ono's nude cover was shot in Ringo's flat.

**17. Music, Fashion and Fruit, *3 Saville Row***

Once the home to the Beatles 'Apple headquarters'

**18. Not Queer, Not Jewish, 7 Duke Street**

John Lennon's immortal words to Tony Barrow

**19. Olympic Studios, 117 Church Road, Barnes, London**

The studios where Jimi Hendrix recorded Are You Experienced?

**20. Paul McCartney's Busking, Leicester Square Tube station, London**

This is where Paul McCartney went busking for a film in 1984.

**21. Paul McCartney's London Home, 7 Cavendish Avenue, St Johns Wood, London**

This is Paul McCartney's London home of 40+ years.

**22. Ringo Drinks A Pint, 28 Winchester Road**

'A Hard Day's Night' filmed here - The Turks Head pub

**23. Ringo Starr lived here, Round Hill, Compton Avenue, Highgate**

Beatle drummer Ringo lived here between 1969 and 1973.

**24. The Beatles Apple Shop, 94 Baker Street, London**

The site of the famous Beatles Apple Store in 1967-68.

**25. The Butcher Sessions, 1 The Vale, King's Road**

Bizarre photo shoot of the 'The Beatles' took place here

**26. The Crawdaddy Club, Station Hotel, Richmond (opposite the railway st**

This is where the infamous Crawdaddy club was home to the Stones

**27. The Palladium, Argyll Street, London**

One of London's most prestigious and largest theatres.

**28. The Scotch, 13 Masons Yard, St James, London**

The Scotch of St James, swinging sixties celeb music club.

**29. The Speakeasy Club, 48 Margaret Street, London**

This is the site of The Speakeasy Club, infamous rock venue.

**30. The Turkish Beatles, 28 Winchester Road, St Margarets, Twickenham, Mi**

The Beatles, crew, cast & production team wrap party pub

**31. Trident Sound Studios, 17 St Annes Court, London**

Infamous recording studios to the stars.

**32. Sergeant Pepper Covered, 4 Chelsea Manor Studios, 1 Flood Street, Chelsea**

This is where Sergeant Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band was shot

**33. A Comic Legends resting place, Kew Meadow Path, Richmond**

The greatest magic comic of his generation or indeed ever

**34. The Beatles Coffee Shop, *St. John's Wood Underground Station, Finchley Ro***  
The Beatles Coffee Shop near the Abbey Road crossing.
